Dear Parents of "Created To Be Me" campers,

On behalf of CLER Ministries® (CLER) thank you for enrolling your youth in a one-of-a-kind church camping experience, entitled "Created To Be Me"® (better known as Eighter's). This curriculum was designed by Rev. Linda Goddard, a Christian Sexuality Education Minister and since 1988, we have been striving to provide comprehensive, age appropriate Christian sexuality education. Our goal is to help students pursue wholeness, physically and spiritually, in this important area of their lives.

The purpose of this letter is to inform parents with regard to the content of our curriculum. Please review the following overview of the Keynote and Workshop information for a better understanding. The keynotes and workshops afford us an opportunity to give in-depth presentations on the subjects of love, dating, peer-pressure, marriage, sexual intimacy, contraception and personal accountability, all from a spiritual and Biblical perspective. The "Created To Be Me"® curriculum strongly teaches abstinence as the best decision prior to a committed marriage relationship. The workshops are built around the theme that God has designed sexual intimacy to be a powerful and wonderful gift to be opened and enjoyed within marriage. However, as we have seen by the teen pregnancy statistics, "Abstinence Only" programs are not enough. CLER believes youth should be educated comprehensively regarding the prevention of unwanted pregnancies and sexually transmitted infections, as well as the emotional consequences of early sexual activity. Although young people are exposed to widespread advertising about many forms of contraception, it is our experience that they are not informed about their proper use. However, when youth do get the facts, they tend to make more responsible choices.

Everything in the curriculum that is presented in our large group setting is also discussed in a Small Group atmosphere with trained Small Group Leaders. Youth will also participate in activities to help process the information and assist in leading worship services each evening that will reinforce the theme of the day.

In closing, we want to tell you how fortunate we believe your young person is to be able to come together for a week to explore this subject from a loving and Christian perspective. Youth and staff leave this camp having learned a great deal about themselves, others, and most importantly, how our loving God wants this wonderful gift of sexual intimacy to be enjoyed by us in a loving committed relationship.
